## All registered nurses seeking admission to the BSN program must submit the following credentials:

- 1. Completion of all pre-clinical course requirements with a minimum grade of "C" and a cumulative GPA of 2.50.
- 2. Students must present validation of an associate degree in nursing from a Texas nursing associate degree program or an NLN out-of-state accredited nursing program.
- 3. Documentation of a current license to practice nursing in the State of Texas.
- 4. Documentation of recent nursing practice of at least 6 months full-time or 1 year part-time or a refresher course with a clinical component within the last 2 years.

Deadlines are March 1st for Fall and October 1st for spring.

Thirty-five (35) semester hours will be awarded toward the BSN degree for nurses who have submitted the above credentials and who have completed the first 12 credit hours in the RN to BSN program.
