Hello all,

Based on the agreement reached at our faculty retreat last December, to provide students with more access to faculty in the department and to help with mentoring and professionalism, all 10 graduate students currently enrolled have been assigned four possible advisors with whom they can choose to work.

This way, a student can select the faculty member whose research best matches his or her ideas for a Master's Thesis or simply see whoever is available at any given time.

All four of us (Chatha, Jocson, Scott, and Wakefield) will have access to all MA students' alternate registration PINs in Panthertracks. Dr. Palmer also can find this information in native Banner.

Attached are Excel files with degree plans for nine students; XXXXXXXX, #10, is supposed to graduate this semester. I will notify the students of the changes to the advising procedure shortly before early registration opens for Summer and Fall 2009.
