All of its graduate degree programs are offered on the main campus at Prairie View; however, selected degree programs in education, business, engineering, and nursing are offered at distance sites primarily in the Houston area. Off-campus sites are currently located in Spring, Texas at the Prairie View A&M University Northwest Graduate Center, the campus of the College of Nursing in downtown Houston, and the University Center in The Woodlands, Texas.
