NACELink ([Panthers Career Zone](#)) is the official job and internship listing database for Prairie View A&M University students, alumni and employers. Registering with NACELink allows you to view internship and job vacancy listings 24/7 via the web. You can upload fully formatted resumes (up to 10 different versions) and a cover letter to use to apply for jobs and internships you see posted on NACELink.

NACELink is the system used by our office to manage on-campus interviews. To use NACELink, you must first register with NACELink and upload your resume(s). With NACELink you will be able to see who is interviewing, sign-up for interviews, submit your resume(s) to employers and keep track of these submissions, change your interview times and/or cancel interviews, find out about employer group meetings/information sessions, and much more.
